Social Media Moderation

CCRG Admins on our various social media platforms reserve the right to delete comments, mute, or block contributors.

Grounds for these actions include (but are not limited to) these following Considerations:

1. Obsessive arguing & repetition
2. Unapproved promotion of products and/or services
3. Use of multiple anonymous identities
4. Sexist, racist or other offensive comments
5. Repeated provocative contrariness or pedantry (i.e. trolling)
Unnecessarily long comments
6. Personal attacks
7. Intimidation
8. Unsubstantiated conspiracy theories

We will also consider a contributor's presence across other social media platforms.

This presence across other platforms is considered their 'medium'. Just as a publisher may choose to not host content from specific companies across their range of publications or outlets, CCRG may evaluate a contributor's 'medium' against the above Considerations when determining whether to delete, mute or block.
