Original needs in 1920: - Effects of World War I – fatherless families, alcohol abuse, homelessness

**Depression 1930s** – unemployment, poverty

Post World War II - housing for the elderly - Selwyn Village

**1980s** - Aids epidemic – ACM set up hospice to care for Aids sufferers

**2017** – Chronic homelessness, addiction, poverty, food insecurity




